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

Domaine Bousquet

The Bousquet family relocated to the foothills of the Andes from the South of France in 1997. Their aim was to bring together traditional French winemaking practices along with the ideal agricultural conditions Mendoza had to offer. Based in Tupungato, their 110-hectare vineyard is at an altitude of 1200m. Along with being one of the highest vineyards in the world, the unique cool nights and constant breeze, as well as very low rainfall, creates perfect conditions for the production of organically grown ripe fruit, with bright acidity.

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Durigutti

Durigutti Family Winemakers is a family winery founded in 2002 by brothers and winemakers Héctor and Pablo Durigutti. The winery is located in the heart of Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza – the spiritual home of Argentinian Malbec. This family venture has grown and developed in just over two decades to encompass wine production, regional tourism and hospitality; grounded in the principles of agro-ecological sustainability and the preservation of regional heritage. Their winemaking philosophy is to produce wines that reflect the terroir and the identity of each vineyard, using organic, minimal intervention and sustainable practices. Héctor and Pablo were named Winemakers of the Year by Tim Atkin MW in his 2023 Argentina Special Report.

Patricio Gouguenheim's love of wine started at an early age when his French parents gave him a little bit of wine mixed with sparkling water. Many years later, his interest and passion for wine alongside his dream of producing wines which he could be proud of, led him to establish the estate. Located 45 miles from the city of Mendoza in the foothills of the Andes, Gouguenheim is one of the best-kept secrets in the Uco Valley. Situated at an altitude of 3,600 feet (one of the highest estates in Mendoza), the estate benefits from the vast temperature difference between day and night which together with irrigation from the Andes snowmelt, allows the estate to produce fruit with optimum ripening and concentration. With the expertise of Patricio and his winemaking team, the resulting wines offer impeccable quality and great value.

They are the largest Certified Sustainable Winery in the Adelaide Hills and are accredited with a 5 Red Star Halliday Wine Companion rating for regularly producing wines of exemplary quality and typicity.

It was the first English estate to plant traditional Champagne grapes in 1986. They have been producing award-winning wines ever since and set the standard in quality English wine production.

Château La Croix du Duc

This 15 hectare estate is located next to Lussac St Emilion and has been in the hands of the Chollet family since 1865. The vines are located on clay and gravel hillsides facing south west with traditional winemaking techniques used. 80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon.

Château la Hase

Owned by Jean-Yves Millaire, Château La Hase is a small, boutique 6.5-hectare estate located near Fronsac with one hectare of 45-year-old vines. The varieties are Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon, and they are grown with the same care as a Grand Cru: no weedkillers, ploughing, crop-thinning and all hand-picked. The estate is named after 'La Hase', a female hare, in honor of M. Millaire's grandfather who taught him how to hunt. The wine is organic and biodynamic.

Château Argadens Bordeaux superieur

Since 2002, Château Argadens has been owned by the Sichel family, who are also part owners of Château Palmer and several other iconic estates in the region. Their aim is to make the wine a benchmark within the Bordeaux Supérieur appellation. Grapes are sourced from a parcel of 45 hectares located in Entre-Deux-Mers and the wine spends twelve months in oak barrels. The winery is named after the family which founded the estate in the thirteenth century.

Château Brisson côtes de Castillon

Located in Belvès-de-Castillon on the north bank of the Dordogne, east of St-Émilion, Château Brisson has been owned by Paul Valdés since 1980. The estate spans 18 hectares and is primarily planted with Merlot, which have an average age of over 30 years. Harvesting is done by hand, yields are kept low, and every effort is made to enhance the biodiversity of the soil. Paul and his son Cedric's meticulous management of the vineyard produces wines that are generous and well-balanced.

Château Reynier entre-deux-mers

Château Reynier is located in the Entre-Deux-Mers appellation and dates back to the fifteenth century. Since 1901 the Lurton family have been custodians of this historic estate. The property is now run by Marc Lurton, the fourth generation, who alongside his daughter Pauline (the fifth generation to work at the estate), is committed to combining traditional and modern winemaking techniques to produce wines which are excellent value and great quality examples of Bordeaux varieties. All of Château Reynier's wines are certified Organic and Vegan from the 2022 vintage onwards.

Château George 7

Château George 7 FRONSAC

Château George 7 is a new boutique winery in Fronsac, which is a lesser-known right bank appellation in Bordeaux near Pomerol and St-Émilion. The estate's owner Sally Evans, purchased what was a dilapidated property with 35-year-old Merlot vines in 2015, since then Sally has built a new winery and tasting facility which will ensure the estate's legacy lives on. Committed to sustainability, Château George 7 has shifted to a holistic approach to viticulture and has the highest level of High Environmental Value certification. Changes include mechanical weeding, planting hedgerows for biodiversity to retain balance in the vineyard along with a review of all packaging to ensure sustainability is considered at every stage.

Château Beaumont HAUT-MÉDOC

This expansive estate, which was originally founded in 1824, is ideally located in the centre of the Médoc region, between Saint-Julien and Margaux. Thirty years later, the beautiful Renaissance mansard style castle and vineyards are owned by the GMF (Grands Millésimes de France) group, also owner of Château Beychevelle. With the aim of producing rich and crowd pleasing wine, they have hired consultant Eric Boissenot, a rewn oenologist in Bordeaux who is involved in many estates including Château Latour, Château Margaux, Château Lafite-Rothschild and Château Mouton-Rothschild.

Château Cantemerle HAUT-MÉDOC

Château Cantemerle's vineyard is situated on deep gravel soil between the communes of Macau and Ludon, spanning over 90 hectares. Although it was not initially included in the original 1855 Classification, thanks to the efforts of its owner Caroline de Villeneuve Durfort, Château Cantemerle was added to the list as a Fifth Growth just a few months later. This entry became the first modification to the 1855 Classification.

Château du Moulin Rouge **HAUT-MÉDOC**

Château du Moulin Rouge, a small but perfectly formed Cru Bourgeois Supérieur estate, was first founded in the eighteenth century and has been owned by the same family for thirteen generations. Situated between Margaux and St Julien, the 27 hectare estate is now under the custodianship of brother and sister Lucie Secret and Geoffrey Ribeiro. Just as the generations before them have done, Lucie and Geoffrey are dedicated to respecting the heritage of the estate and winemaking style whilst ensuring that the estate's commitment to sustainable viticulture and modern winemaking allows the Château continue to produce meticulously crafted wines for generations to come.

Château Lanessan HAUT-MÉDOC

Lanessan is an estate that fully deserves its Cru Bourgeois status. It is ideally located on a gravelly plateau in the centre of the Médoc, towards Saint-Julien, overlooking the Gironde. Since 2009, it has been managed by their dynamic winemaker, Paz Espajo. The vineyard spans 45 hectares and the vines have an average age of 30 years.

Château Les Hauts Conseillants is the realisation of one man's determination. In 1973, Léopold Figeac decided to restore the four-hectare estate in Lalande de Pomerol. Later, he purchased an additional six hectares with his daughter and son-in-law. All his efforts have been justified, as the Château is now highly regarded in the appellation and is currently managed by his grandson, Jean Baptiste Bourotte.

Covering 81 hectares with vines averaging 25 years old, Château Angludet is one of the oldest estates in the Médoc, which has, over time, proven its name to be synonymous with quality. Château Kirwan MARGAUX

Third growth property Château Kirwan, named after it's Irish proprietor, has been in fine form in recent years. Since 1925, Kirwan has been owned by the négociant, Schröder and Schÿler. This beautiful eighteenth century Château has 35 hectares of vineyards. The wine is typically composed of 40% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc, and 10% Petit Verdot. Grapes are hand-harvested and then fermented in temperature-controlled, stainlesssteel tanks. The wine is then matured in oak barriques (30-50% new) for 18 months.

Six generations of the Cruse family have overseen the vast Laujac estate, which is situated in the heart of the Médoc region, for over two centuries. It spans 400 hectares in total, with 75 hectares dedicated to vineyards, two of which are classified as Crus Bourgeois Supérieur. The Domaine embraces the traditions and expertise passed down generation-to-generation, as well as implementing developments in modern winemaking and viticulture.

Château Rocher-Calon Montagne-Saint-Émilion

After returning home from WW1, Pierre Lagardere, the great-grandfather of the current owner Gaël, purchased a hectare of land in Pomerol. Over the next four generations, the family expanded their acreage by acquiring new vineyards throughout Libournais and investing in state-of-the-art equipment, including temperature-controlled ageing cellars, a pneumatic wine press, and micro-oxygenation equipment. Château Rocher-Calon is located on some of the best soils in Montagne-St-Émilion and typically comprises a blend of 95% Merlot and 5% Cabernet Franc. A qualitative approach to viticulture is standard practice, with green harvesting, leaf removal, and hand-picking being the norm.

Château Mauvesin Barton moulis-en-médoc

Château Mauvesin is located in Moulis-en-Médoc, between the prestigious Margaux and Saint Julien appellations. The estate dates back to the fifteenth century and was owned by the Baritault family for four generations until 2011, when it was purchased by Lilian and Michel Barton Sartorius. The Barton family have also owned Crus Classés Châteaux Langoa and Léoville Barton in Saint Julien for eight generations. The Château Mauvesin Barton vineyards cover 50 hectares, with an average vine age of 35 years.

Château Bellegrave PAUILLAC

Domaine Tollot Beaut côte de BEAUNE

Domaine Tollot-Beaut was among the group of pioneering Burgundians who started producing and bottling their own wines in the early part of the 20th century. As rich in tradition as this Domaine has, under Nathalie Tollot, no one rests on their laurels, and a premium is placed on quality. A significant amount of money is invested in oak every year to ensure a good stock of healthy barrels, which provide the perfect resting place for their magnificent wines. However, it is the vineyard where most of the investment goes. They employ twice as many people per hectare as any of their neighbours, with their efforts focussed on restricting the vigour of the vines and therefore increasing the chances of ripe, concentrated grapes being produced every year. The wines remain respectful to their origins while sharing characteristic spicy, toasty, and cherry fruit flavours.



Since purchasing the Château in 2018, French-American couple Constance and Lawrence Slaughter have transformed the estate by converting to organic practices, transitioning to biodynamic cultivation, developing an active biodiversity strategy, and modernising winemaking tools. The vineyard is north-facing and has a wide range of soils and grape varieties, with old vines between 50 and 70 years. Its altitude of 200-400 meters and location between the southern Rhône valley and high Provençal plateaus create a wonderful micro-climate. Combined with the significant number of old vines and low yields, this results in wines with exceptional freshness, fruit, and character.

Today, his sons, Davide and Daniele run the estate adhering to mainly traditional methods of vinification, but has also integrated modern winemaking techniques.

Rías Baixas

Adegas Pombal a Lanzada

Adegas Pombal a Lanzada is a small family owned and operated winery drawing from two hectares of vines from some of the finest terroirs of Rías Baixas. The name derives from a long stretch of beach, which the winery overlooks called 'La Playa Lanzada'. The family has been growing grapes and producing wine from their vines for generations, they have only recently made the wine commercially available to the general public. All of the vines are cultivated organically and hand harvested before undertaking fermentation in stainless steel tanks using indigenous yeasts. Malolactic fermentation is prevented from taking place in order to preserve the purity of fruit, with six months ageing on the lees to provide extra depth and complexity.

Bodegas de la Marquesa

Established in the second half of the 19th century, this long-established family owned Bodega lies in the village of Villabuena, drawing fruit from estate-owned vineyards on the limestone ridges of Rioja Alavesa in Northern Spain. The estate's founder, Francisco Javier Solano y Eulate, the then Marquis of the Solana following the advice of a famous Bordeaux winemaker started ageing their wines according to methods widely used in Médoc and decided to sell them after further bottle ageing. Four generations later, the Bodegas, is under the custodianship of Juan Pablo De Simón and Milans del Bosch, great-grandsons of Francisco, who continue to produce wines in the same style and winemaking philosophy that inspired the Marquis of the Solana as well as embracing modern winemaking methods.

Bodegas Miguel Merino

Bodega Miguel Merino is one of the smallest cellars of DOC Rioja. It was founded in 1994 by Miguel Merino Snr, who after many years exporting Spanish wines throughout the world, he made his dream of having a small 'bodega' to make the best possible wines, come true. Miguel established his winery in Briones, one of the most beautiful villages in Rioja and most importantly one of the few areas in Rioja Alta that kept old vineyards. All of the bodega's vineyards are from the surrounding area, spread across no less than 34 parcels of land planted under vine between the end of the 19th century and 2001. The vineyard holdings total almost 13 hectares with just 55,000kgs of grapes harvested on average each year. Traditional and sustainable viticulture practices are followed with no use of herbicides and most of the work carried out by hand. The bodega's reputation has soared in recent years under the stewardship of Miguel's son (also Miguel), reinforced by the recent elevation to Rioja First Growth in Tim Atkin's annual classification.


