# BURGUNDY REPORT

## 2022

After 2021's homage to a more 'classic' vintage for Burgundy, the warm and dry summer of 2022 marks a return to another 'vintage of the future', following the trilogy of solar vintages that were 2018, 2019 and 2020. However, this latest addition to the string of vintages marked by climate change positively attests to the region's ability to firmly keep a hold on its identity.

We were in Burgundy in the last week of October, and at this early stage we believe that 2022 is not just better than the aforementioned, it's up there with the best vintages ever produced in this famous region. It's worth noting there are some important differences between 2022 and the recent vintages that precede it. Firstly and perhaps most importantly, the cellars are full and the winemakers are smiling, following what Michelot's Nicolas Mestre called '*an easy growing season, followed by another one*' (referring to 2023 which they had just finished picking, and which will be even bigger!). Visit after visit, winemaker after winemaker, we couldn't find any examples of challenges during the vintage. '*No stress and nothing excessive*', was Alex Bachelet's take on the vintage, which he says '*lets the terroir speak clearly, not the man.*'

For opposing reasons, both 2020 and 2021 were very short on quantity: 2020 for drought and 2021 for frosts. Although temperatures of -4°C in April 2022 raised concerns of similar climatic threats, the disastrous levels of -7°C coupled with the snow that blighted 2021 were not repeated in 2022, thankfully. It is undeniable that recent vintages have seen an increase in unpredictable and more extreme weather, with earlier spring budding and the threat of frost – a potentially deadly combination for the vines.

As we've seen in previous vintages (such as 1992 following 1991), years that follow those affected by heavy frost damage will often bounce back with more volume, as has fortunately happened in 2022 where volumes are up 75% on average against 2021.

A guiding principle in *preparing for tomorrow*, now followed by most of the winemakers in the Cote d'Or, is what sets this vintage apart from those before it. 2022 is the new Burgundy all winemakers will aspire to when it comes to the vintages of tomorrow. Those who have been preparing for earlier, warmer and drier seasons are the ones producing exceptional wines in what is becoming the new order of climatic conditions in the Cote d'Or.

2022 is the most joyful vintage I have tasted at this early stage. Whether you're already a member of the Burgundy choir, or yet to acquire the Burgundy bug, this vintage is quite simply unmissable.

# THE GROWING SEASON

- A well-watered winter during the end of 2021 and early 2022 meant there was no excess, yet just enough to see the vines through what would be a very dry growing season.
- There was some frost and hail, but most was seen before bud-break. Small damage caused by frost was seen in Chablis, and by hail in the Mâconnais and Côte Chalonnaise.
- Although this was the driest and warmest for over 100 years, there were none of the extreme temperatures that 2003, 2018, 2019 and 2020 witnessed.
- June's rainfall fell largely over Gevrey Chambertin, which saw a month's rainfall (90mm) in 30 minutes on 12<sup>th</sup> June, and a further 90mm over the course of the rest of that week, giving the area a quarter of a year's rainfall in just one week.
- Although falling predominantly over Gevrey Chambertin, the rain managed to reach all areas, providing just enough water for the vines to get through the hot summer ahead.
- Temperature peaks of 35°C and 36°C were mitigated by June's and August's rainfall.
- Harvest started at the end of August in the Côte de Beaune and at the start of September in the Côte-de-Nuits.

# THE WINES

Both whites and reds are an absolute pleasure to taste, where the profiles of each village are charming and easy to access. Alcohols are moderate, usually capped at 13.5%, and while the fruit is concentrated, it is delightfully fresh. There is structure but the tannins are sweet. This is a pleasingly complete vintage and one which will offer excellence across the board.

## Whites

Harmonious and generous, the whites show excellent ripeness without moving into the tropical spectrum. While acidity is not racy, the wines are very well balanced and in most villages the terroir shines through. Florals, stone fruit, texture and concentration. I particularly enjoyed some of the village level Chassagne, and at the other end of the Cote d'Or, the mineralité of the Marsannays is very exciting. The vintage has also suited Aligoté on the best sites very well.

## Reds

Concentrated and ripe while maintaining a classic Burgundian elegance and sweet tannic structure, these wines are going to be very difficult to resist in youth, but have the freshness and complexity to age well. The fruit is generous across all spectrums, from *croquant* blackberry to ripe and creamy strawberry, and on the top sites there is profound complexity and depth. It's early doors, but this could go down as one of the greatest ever vintages for red Burgundy.

Hopeful that there won't be many price increases on last year, and equally hopeful of increased allocations across the most-highly prized wines, 2022 Burgundy promises much excitement as it comes back from a tough few years. There is immediate appeal across all levels here, but we should draw your attention to more affordable wines at the Bourgogne and Villages levels, where the Domaines have been able to craft some stunning wines which punch well above their label.

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# CHABLIS

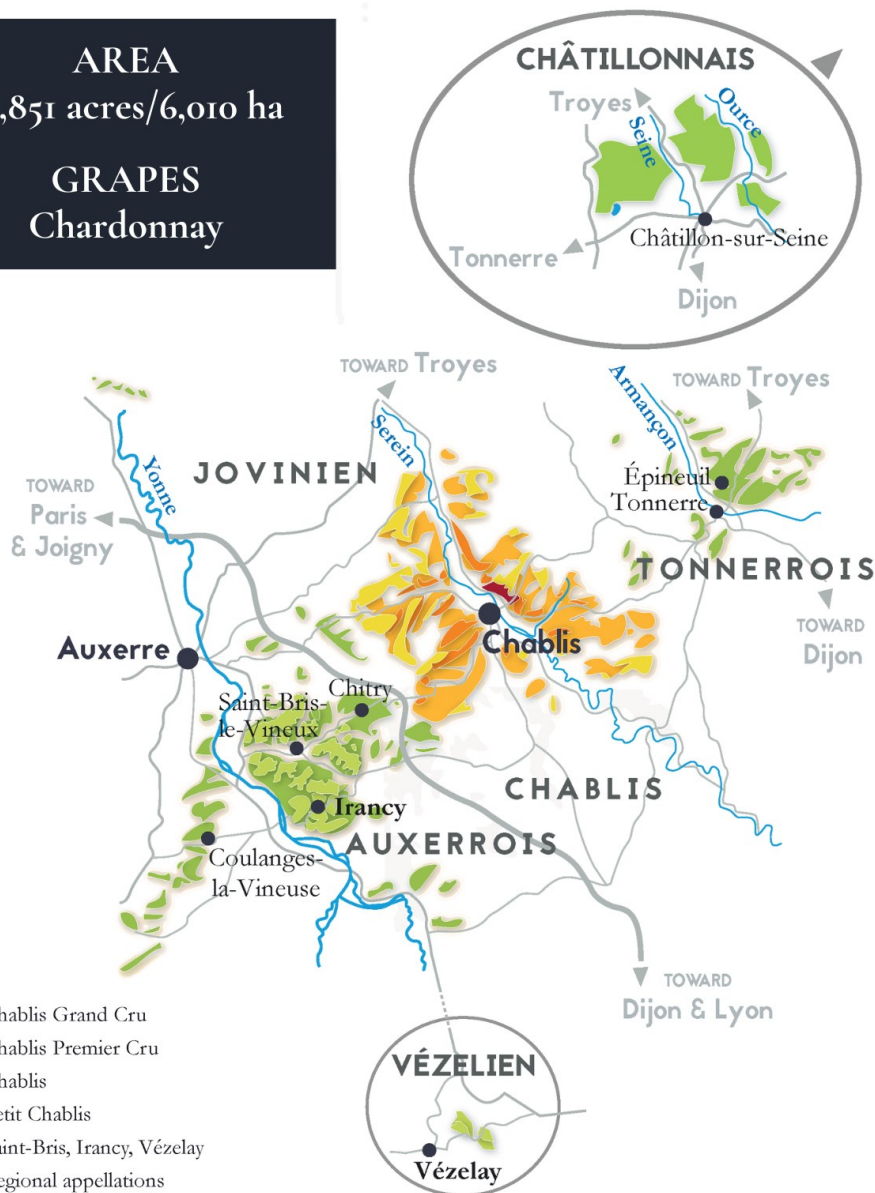
Mid-way between Beaune and Paris, the Chablis winegrowing region stretches over around 20 communes. Nestled among the valleys and wooded hilltops, the vineyards cover the hillsides running alongside the pretty Serein Valley. The vines sink their roots deep into the clay-limestone soil, drawing on them for their characteristic mineral aromas, to the delight of Chablis drinkers.

# DOMAINE SAMUEL BILLAUD

## Chablis



Samuel continues to make some of the most exciting wines coming out of Chablis today, equal in quality to those of Jean-Marie and Bernard Raveneau but at a fraction of the price. Samuel ages his wines for at least ten months on the fine lees to achieve a winning combination of ripe, apple fruit on the nose, fresh, succulent texture on the palate and fine minerality and salinity on the finish.

Coming from a plot just above the Grand Cru of Le Clos, Samuel's 'deluxe' Petit Chablis is something of an insiders tip and a wine that we can never get enough of. Anyone that says Petit Chablis can't be complex is yet to try this. Wonderfully precise with a touch of saline minerality to the peachy fruit. Get yours quickly, this is sure to sell out fast.

<p>Impressively textural across the palate, with great depth and a long, mineral finish. A peachiness to the fruit profile in this warmer vintage, retaining a freshness and notes of ripe apple.</p>

<p>A rounded style, with supple, generous citrus and stone fruits. Great freshness on the finish. A natural concentration which is the result of low yields, there is a lovely vibrancy to this wine in 2022.</p>		
<b>2022 Chablis 1er Cru Vaillons Vieilles Vignes</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£275</b>
<p>Punchy and mineral, this is tight and not the most expressive bottling now, but with excellent density to the fruit. Classically styled with briny, oyster shell notes, this will excel after a little time in the cellar.</p>		
<b>2022 Chablis 1er Cru Montée de Tonnerre</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£295</b>
<p>Stunning balance between fresh, limey notes and rounder, more opulent notes of nectarine. Energetic, with minerality to the fore and a long, vibrant finish.</p>		
<b>2022 Chablis Grand Cru Bougros</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£550</b>
<p>So much power and depth, still wrapped up tightly in this young wine, but the potential for greatness is very clear.</p>		

# DOMAINE WILLIAM FÈVRE

Chablis



The Fèvre family have played a prominent role in the Chablis region for over 250 years and William Fèvre has become one of the biggest landowners in Chablis with 78 hectares of prestigious vineyards, of which 15.9 hectares are classified as premier cru and 15.2 hectares as grand cru. With holdings in six of the seven grand cru appellations, no other producer can claim such a wide array of Chablis' finest vineyards. Year after year, Fèvre is the benchmark for classic Chablis. Fleshy and elegant bouquet revealing citrus, white fruit and floral aromas. The mouth is fresh, supple underscored by mineral notes.		
<b>2022 Chablis 1er Cru Beauroy</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£242</b>
Fresh aromas, with a light floral bouquet and a note of white pepper. On the palate this is fresh, with melon and green apple, with a broadening on the finish, with ripe, pure fruit. Mineral and rounded.		
<b>2022 Chablis 1er Cru Montmains</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£254</b>
Exotic on the nose- quince and a hint of pineapple. Loads of texture on the ripe palate with broad, ripe fruit and a peppery note. Retains a sense of brightness and purity despite the breadth of the wine across the palate.

Vaurent is the only 1er Cru vineyard to share the slope with the cluster of Grands Crus and is often of the same quality level. Dense, yet serene, there is great minerality and tension here, with more to be revealed with time in the cellar.		
<b>2022 Chablis 1er Cru Montée de Tonnerre</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£348</b>
Complex bouquet with floral and fruity aromas, and intense mineral notes. Structured palate in its youth, becoming more subtle and elegant and developing ripe fruit notes.		
<b>2022 Chablis Grand Cru Bougros</b>	<b>3x75cl</b>	<b>£204</b>
This climate lies at the very western end of the Grands Crus area, at altitudes ranging from 130 to 170 m on fairly deep marl and clay terrain with a southwest exposure. On the palate, this appellation's wines are often very full and rich. Rich bouquet with intense mineral notes. Full and round, yet firm and massive on the palate.		
<b>2022 Chablis Grand Cru Les Preuses</b>	<b>3x75cl</b>	<b>£264</b>
Les Preuses is probably taken from the word "Perreuse" (stone), the name given to the ancient Roman road which ran below the current vineyard. Made for ageing thanks to a dense, compact, clay-rich soil resting on a limestone bed. Floral nose, with fruity aromas enhanced by intense mineral notes and developing lightly smoky touches. Very round on the palate, both full-bodied and refined.		
<b>2022 Chablis Grand Cru Bougros Cote de Bouguerots</b>	<b>3x75cl</b>	<b>£324</b>
Bougros sits on a very steep slope, with a gradient of more than 30%, facing due south at the foot of the hill. The shallow soil, a mixture of clay and gravel, prevents excessive yields resulting in complex, robust wines. Complex and mineral bouquet, powerful and dense structure with pleasant roundness.		
<b>2022 Chablis Grand Cru Les Clos</b>	<b>3x75cl</b>	<b>£334</b>
Largest and most famous Grand Cru; its fame based on history as one of Chablis' first vineyards. Enjoys a southerly aspect with very white, dense and deep clay soil, resting on a limestone bed 80 cm below the ground, which brings to the wine those spicy notes so typical of this terroir. Remarkably complex bouquet, blending fruity, floral and spicy notes with a substantial mineral touch. Structured palate, opening up with age to give powerful, generous wines.

# CÔTE DE NUITS

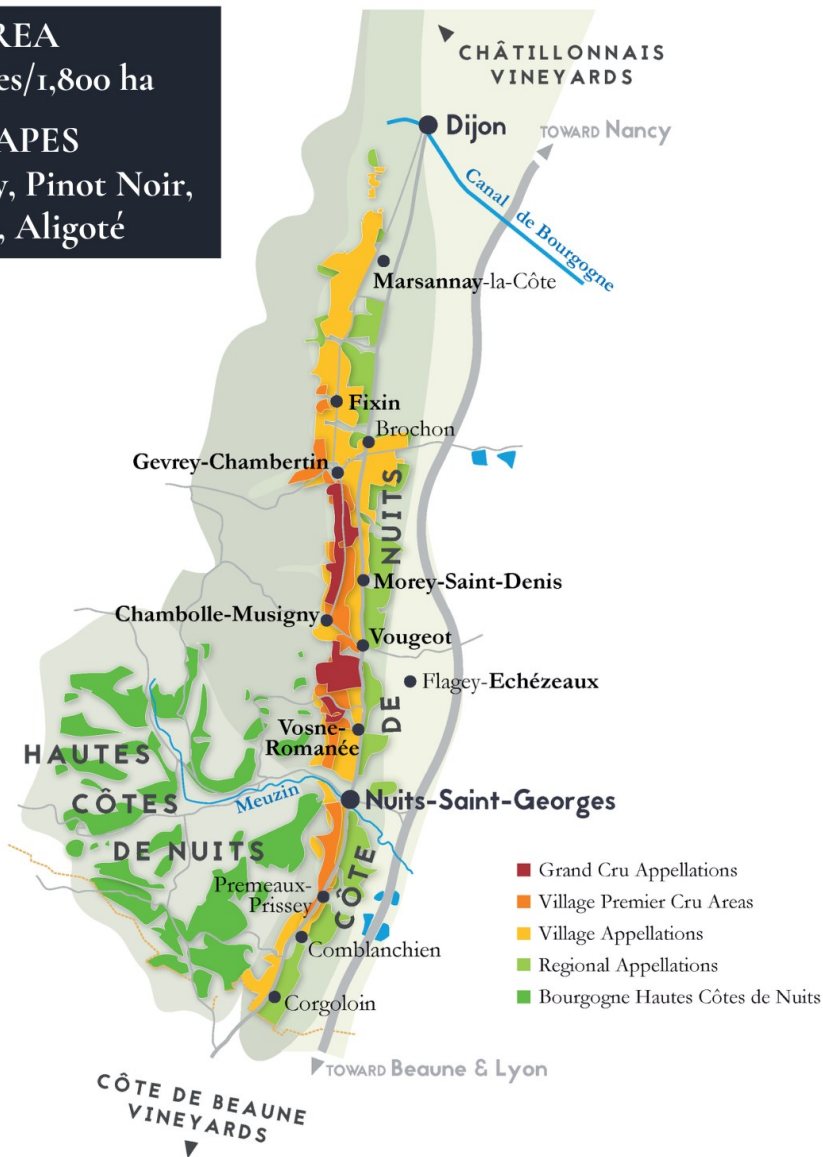
Named after the town of Nuits-St-Georges, this is the northern half of the Côte d'Or, situated between Dijon and Corgoloin, where vines grow along a narrow strip of hillside that is around 20km long and in parts, just 200 metres wide. The Côte de Nuits produces mainly red wine and is a paradise for Pinot Noir. White wines, made from the Chardonnay grape, are fewer and farther between, while fewer still are made from Aligoté.

# DOMAINE REGIS BOUVIER

## Marsannay



Bernard Bouvier took over the vines of his brother Regis in 2019 and now produces these wines in his winery along with those of Domaine Rene Bouvier, where he has been winemaker since 1992. The focus here is on Marsannay, with some of the finest sites in this excellent village represented in the range, although Bernard does produce a range of superb wines from across the Côte-de-Nuits. There is great attention to detail, with viticulture following organic principles (not certified). Grapes are handpicked and sorted on receipt at the winery, with winemaking practices designed to allow for terroir expression. Since tasting for the first time at this domaine, we've been extremely impressed with the wines, with the reds showing great depth and balance and the whites full of verve.

Lemon sherbet aromas, zingy lift and freshness on the palate, with a breadth to the fruit from the warm summer. From vines in in Marsannay and Morey.

Textured on the palate, fresh and classic. Good purity, mid weight and approachable. Half aged in tank and half in large (600 litre) oak barrels. From vines in Marsannay.

<b>2022 Marsannay Vieilles Vignes Blanc</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£155</b>
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Good persistence and fruit, there is more concentration here than in the Bourgogne Chardonnay. In large oak barrels before bottling, around 10-15% of which were new. 60 year old vines.

Fresh red berries, elegant and with some balancing grip on the palate, that marks this out as a relatively serious Bourgogne Rouge. Vines in Marsannay, Fixin and Gevrey.

<b>2022 Marsannay Vieilles Vignes</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£155</b>
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Pleasantly peppery aromas, with deep red cherries and an impressive depth. Quite serious in this vintage, with the old vine (60-70 year old) magic clearly in evidence here. 50% whole bunch fermentation and 20% in new oak.

<b>2022 Marsannay 'Longeroies' Vieilles Vignes</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£175</b>
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From one of Marsannay's best vineyards on clay-rich soils, Longeroies is a site which gives plush, full wines. There is an opulence and viscosity here, with a welcome lift from the whole bunch fermentation (50%).



# DOMAINE DROUHIN-LAROZE

Gevrey-Chambertin



The Drouhin family owns 11 hectares of vines including substantial holdings in some of the most famous Grand Cru sites in the Côte-de-Nuits – few producers can boast holdings in both Musigny and Chambertin. Since the 2014 vintage, Nicholas and Caroline have increasingly taken the reins from their father Philippe. This domaine has a long history of very fine wine making. Caroline also sources grapes from a close-knit group of growers for a range of négociant wines, labelled as Maison Laroze de Drouhin.

Ripe golden apples, peachy, with viscosity and salinity on the palate. An open, expressive and full style of Chardonnay, that reflects the generous nature of the vintage. Aged in large barrels before bottling. From vines in Marsannay and Fixin.

## RED

<b>2022 Bourgogne Côte d'Or Pinot Noir (Laroze de Drouhin)</b>	<b>12x75cl</b>	<b>£220</b>
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From a range of plots, some around Chambolle and Morey. Fresh nose, with red currants and a smooth mouthfeel. Excellent purity. 20% whole bunch fermentation.

Good balance of red and black fruits, displaying classic Gevrey structure. Svelte tannins, with a long, sleek finish.		
<b>2022 Chapelle-Chambertin Grand Cru</b>	<b>3x75cl</b>	<b>£430</b>
Not giving much away on the nose in its youth, with a subtle power across the palate. Very impressive, with dark, almost savoury fruit. 80% new oak, with 15% whole bunches used in fermentation.		
<b>2022 Clos de Vougeot Grand Cru</b>	<b>3x75cl</b>	<b>£475</b>
Mouth-filling and powerful yet smooth and complete. Tightening up on the finish and will require a good few years in the cellar to reveal its charms. 80% new oak, all bunches destemmed.		
<b>2022 Bonnes-Mares Grand Cru</b>	<b>3x75cl</b>	<b>£550</b>
Opulent, expressive and silky-smooth. Exotic spice from the barrel, that will mingle with the dense fruit with time in bottle. 80% new oak and 15% whole bunches.		
<b>2022 Chambertin Clos-de-Bèze Grand Cru</b>	<b>3x75cl</b>	<b>£575</b>
Dense fruit, with wonderful focus and persistence. Black berries and a dark yet fresh spicy note, minerality on the long finish. Harmonious and quite superb.

# DOMAINE MARC ROY

Gevrey-Chambertin



A tiny domaine of just three hectares, overseen by Alexandrine Roy and aided by her semi-retired father, Marc. We've seen something of a cult following develop for these special wines and rightly so, despite the domaine not having any 1er or Grand Crus in the portfolio. The Marsannay and Bourgogne Rouge come highly recommended for earlier drinking and as a gateway into Alexandrine's exceptional winemaking.

## WHITE

<b>2022 Marsannay 'Les Champs Perdrix'</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£250</b>

The perfect balance between immediate charm and depth. Rounded apple fruit, with a gorgeous saline note, this has gone through partial malolactic fermentation and treads the line between freshness and texture with ease.

## RED

Excellent freshness, red fruits shine out of the glass, with an openness and generosity. Good grip makes this a versatile bottling that can be enjoyed by itself or with food. Remarkably good for a Bourgogne Rouge. 50- to 60-year-old vines mostly in Gevrey.

<b>2022 Gevrey-Chambertin Vieilles Vignes</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£370</b>
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From very old vines (80 years old on average), across plots in Gevrey. Open aromatics, spicy pepper alongside black cherry. Superb balance.

<b>2022 Gevrey-Chambertin Clos Prieur</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£405</b>
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Concentrated and dense, with dark plummy fruit and a kick of clove and black pepper. Exceptionally long finish. From old vines bordering Mazis Chambertin.

<b>2022 Gevrey-Chambertin La Justice</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£450</b>
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La Justice' is the vineyard located just behind the estate Alexandrine Roy took over from her father, Marc, in 2003, next to the monopole of Clos de la Justice.

Destemmed fruit from 50+ year old vines leads to a forward and expressive wine with notes of plum, dark cherry and soft earth nuances. A Gevrey of finesse.

<b>2022 Gevrey-Chambertin Cuvée Alexandrine</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£625</b>
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A selection from Alexandrine's favourite six plots, with only the very best berries from each used in this top of the range cuvee. A perennial highlight of the offer each year, this is probably the best edition we've ever tasted - the depth is remarkable and yet with so much power and so much going on in the glass, the wine retains an essence of harmony and serenity. Simply outstanding.

# DOMAINE ROSSIGNOL-TRAPET

Gevrey-Chambertin



Founded in 1990, Domaine Rossignol Trapet somehow feels far more mature, producing some of the region's finest wines, as well as a perennial favourite and top value Bourgogne Rouge. Fully biodynamic, brothers Nicholas and David continue to raise the bar - the biggest problem we have is getting enough wines from them at every level. [View wines online](#)

From vines around Gevrey, there is a freshness and elegance that is so characteristic of the house style. Bright red cherries and a touch of spice on the finish.

<b>2022 Savigny Les Beaune Les Bas-Liards</b>	<b>6x75cl</b>	<b>£165</b>
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Tiny 0.25-hectare plot planted in the early '80s, this vineyard represents a tiny but impactful piece of land. Positioned opposite the esteemed Premier Cru vineyards of Les Rouvrettes and Les Narbatons, it boasts a favorable north-south orientation. Delicate yet captivating scents of strawberry, raspberry, and cranberry intermingle gracefully, accompanied by subtle savory hints. The wine displays a well-rounded structure and harmony, thanks to its velvety texture and gentle tannins that enfold a rich core of bramble and wild fruit.

Open-knitted and ripe, rounded with blueberries. Expressive and generous now, with cellaring potential.

Classic Gevrey dark fruits, with a tight, mineral-tinged finish. Silky tannins and a slight hint of lavender aromas.

Enticing aromatics, with fresh fruits and violet notes alongside exotic spices. Deceptively structured, with plenty more to come here.

Heady aromas, with an array of both red and black fruits, tapenade and fresh black pepper. 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From one of Gevrey's best 1er Cru vineyards and one which always performs well in warmer vintages, due to the way the cool air follows the contours of the hills. Violets, fresh peppery notes and a long, elegant finish. Borders the Grand Cru Clos St Jacques.

Frédéric's vision makes him an outstanding ambassador for Burgundy excellence and approach to terroir. Further to Frédéric's hard work, the domaine acquired organic certification in 2008 and became entirely biodynamic in 2015. As of that year, Frédéric has introduced terracotta jars, which are aromatically neutral, allowing the domaine to craft exemplary wines that respect the purity of the fruit and characteristics of its soil in order to refine the identity of each wine. 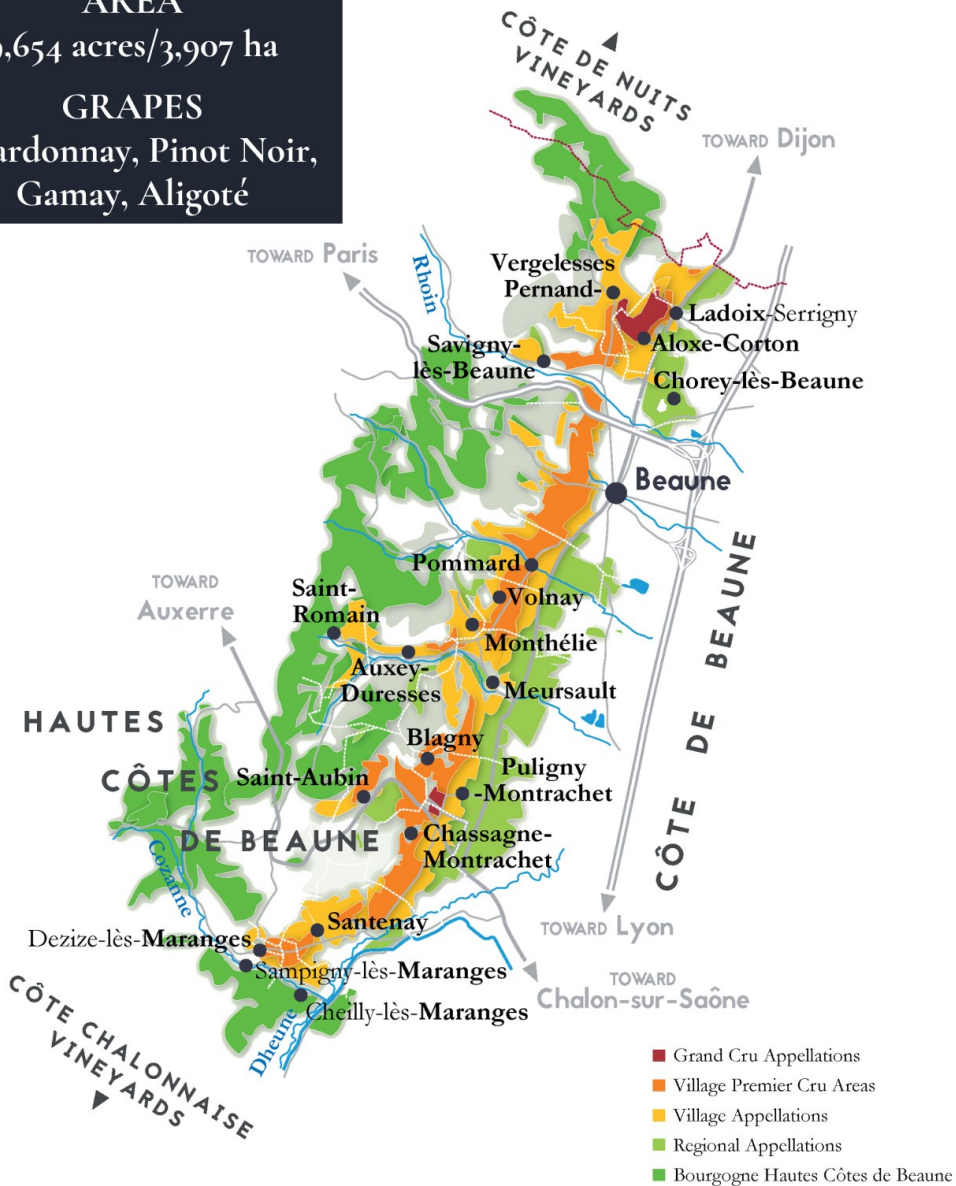

Being the fifth generation of winegrowers in the family, Pascal Prunier took over his father's estate in the 1980s. Today Domaine Pascal Prunier-Bonheur bears the name of both Pascal and his wife, Christine Bonheur. The estate spreads over 8 ha across Saint-Romain towards Auxey-Duresses, Monthelie, Meursault and Pommard. Combining tradition and modernity their wines are known for their elegance and reasonable prices, something that can be difficult to find in Burgundy.

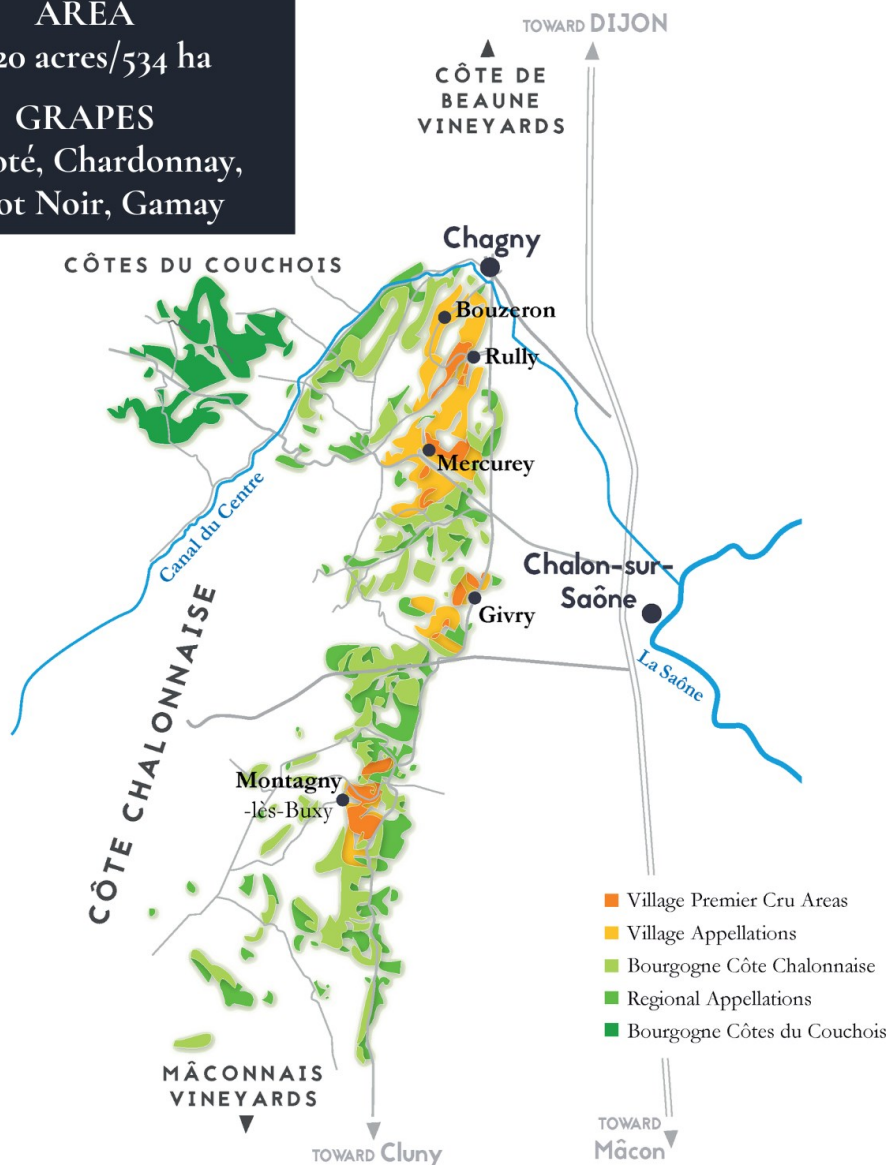
