Domaine Bousquet

The Bousquet family relocated to the foothills of the Andes from the South of France in 1997. Their aim was to bring together traditional French winemaking practices along with the ideal agricultural conditions Mendoza had to offer. Based in Tupungato, their 110-hectare vineyard is at an altitude of 1200m. Along with being one of the highest vineyards in the world, the unique cool nights and constant breeze, as well as very low rainfall, creates perfect conditions for the production of organically grown ripe fruit, with bright acidity.

Durigutti Family Winemakers

Durigutti Family Winemakers is a family winery founded in 2002 by brothers and winemakers Héctor and Pablo Durigutti. The winery is located in the heart of Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza – the spiritual home of Argentinian Malbec. This family venture has grown and developed in just over two decades to encompass wine production, regional tourism and hospitality; grounded in the principles of agro-ecological sustainability and the preservation of regional heritage. Their winemaking philosophy is to produce wines that reflect the terroir and the identity of each vineyard, using organic, minimal intervention and sustainable practices. Héctor and Pablo were named Winemakers of the Year by Tim Atkin MW in his 2023 Argentina Special Report.

Gouguenheim Winery

Patricio Gouguenheim's love of wine started at an early age when his French parents gave him a little bit of wine mixed with sparkling water. Many years later, his interest and passion for wine alongside his dream of producing wines which he could be proud of, led him to establish the estate. Located 45 miles from the city of Mendoza in the foothills of the Andes, Gouguenheim is one of the best-kept secrets in the Uco Valley. Situated at an altitude of 3,600 feet (one of the highest estates in Mendoza), the estate benefits from the vast temperature difference between day and night which together with irrigation from the Andes snowmelt, allows the estate to produce fruit with optimum ripening and concentration. With the expertise of Patricio and his winemaking team, the resulting wines offer impeccable quality and great value.

Sidewood Estate ADELAIDE HILLS

Sidewood Estate is a family-owned estate located in the Adelaide Hills, the heart of Australian cool climate wine production. In 2004, Owen and Cassandra Inglis purchased the estate with the goal of creating elegant and stylish wines, focused on quality and underpinned by impeccable winemaking which reflect the beauty of the region. Every wine produced from the estate is made from carefully handpicked fruit from selected rows across their 300-acres of vineyards, before being entrusted to internationally acclaimed winemaker Darryl Catlin. They are the largest Certified Sustainable Winery in the Adelaide Hills and are accredited with a 5 Red Star Halliday Wine Companion rating for regularly producing wines of exemplary quality and typicity.

Bethany Wines BAROSSA

The Schrapel family was one of the first to settle in the Barossa Valley and planted their first vineyards in 1852. 130 years later, fifth generation brothers Robert and Geoff established Bethany Wines. Using minimal intervention, they produce exceptional wines that reflects the nature of Barossa's microclimate. Facing west, their vineyards benefit from cooling gully breezes during spring and summer which extend the ripening season and allow the grapes to achieve the right level of sugar and acid. Today the winery is run by Tania Schrapel, Geoff's daughter, who continues the legacy of the business.

Leconfield Wines COONAWARRA

Dating back to the establishment of South Australia's first vineyard in 1837, Leconfield is home of two of South Australia's leading wine estate: Leconfield Coonawarra and Richard Hamilton Wines. Named after his English ancestor Lord Leconfield, winemaker Sydney Hamilton selected a fine piece of 'Terra Rossa' country at Coonawarra in 1974 to fulfil his life's ambition: growing and producing a classic Australian Cabernet Sauvignon. Richard Hamilton, fifth generation wine grower, established his own winery at McLaren Vale in 1972. Together with his wife Jette, they have built up their vineyard holdings, some of which are in excess of 100 years old.

Russell and Sutor

After studying viticulture, Alex Russell became an experimental winemaker at the Riverland Vine Improvement Committee (RVIC), a nursery that specialises in new and alternate grape varieties. Loving to craft wines, Alex played with locally grown grapes – usually reserved to produce Australia's fortified wine – which led him to launch his first label 'Alejandro' in 2014. He focuses on producing rare varieties, and set himself up at the border of Murray Darling, an exciting region which is seeing a rebirth of small-scale and premium wineries.

Curly Flat VICTORIA

Located in the Macedon Ranges, south of Victoria, Curly Flat was founded by Phillip Moraghan and Jenifer Kolkka in 1989. Benefitting from the coolest vineyards in mainland Australia, the 14 hectares of vines are ideal for growing early ripening grapes. The vineyard is planted with Pinot Noir (69%), Chardonnay (26%), and Pinot Gris (5%). Following sustainable practice, they no longer use herbicides. All wines are fermented with natural yeasts.

Recognising the unique climate provided by prevailing coastal breezes and abundant sunshine, matched with a rich diversity of soils spread over rolling hills in Licanten, the Orueta family established their Idahue Estate. Despite the region being given D.O status in 2018, La Roncière are still the only producer in Licanten and its potential is just starting to be unlocked.

Nyetimber

Nyetimber is located in West Sussex and only produces sparkling wine sourced from their own vineyards. Nyetimber derives from 'Nitimbrea', the name of the land a millennium ago, meaning a new timber house or a small timber plantation. It was the first English estate to plant traditional Champagne grapes in 1986. They have been producing award-winning wines ever since and set the standard in quality English wine production.

The estate is run by Martine Becker and her brothers Jean Philippe and Jean Francois. Their certification reinforces their attention to detail, respect for their unique terroir and dedication to producing wines of the highest standard.

Château la Hase BORDEAUX AOC

Owned by Jean-Yves Millaire, Château la Hase is a boutique 6.5-hectare estate located near Fronsac with one hectare of 45-year-old vines. The varieties are Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon, and they are grown with the same care as a Grand Cru: no weedkillers, ploughing, crop-thinning and all hand-picked. The estate is named after 'La Hase', a female hare, in honor of M. Millaire's grandfather who taught him how to hunt.

Château Argadens BORDEAUX SUPERIEUR

Since 2002, Château Argadens has been owned by the Sichel family, who are also part owners of Château Palmer and several other iconic estates in the region. Their aim is to make the wine a benchmark within the Bordeaux Supérieur appellation. Grapes are sourced from a parcel of 45 hectares located in Entre-Deux-Mers and the wine spends twelve months in oak barrels. The winery is named after the family which founded the estate in the thirteenth century.

Château Brisson CÔTES DE CASTILLON

Located in Belvès-de-Castillon on the north bank of the Dordogne, east of St-Émilion, Château Brisson has been owned by Paul Valdés since 1980. The estate spans 18 hectares and is primarily planted with Merlot, which have an average age of over 30 years. Harvesting is done by hand, yields are kept low, and every effort is made to enhance the biodiversity of the soil. Paul and his son Cedric's meticulous management of the vineyard produces wines that are generous and well-balanced.

Château Reynier ENTRE-DEUX-MERS

Château Reynier is located in the Entre-Deux-Mers appellation and dates back to the fifteenth century. Since 1901 the Lurton family have been custodians of this historic estate. The property is now run by Marc Lurton, the fourth generation, who alongside his daughter Pauline (the fifth generation to work at the estate) is committed to combining traditional and modern winemaking techniques to produce wines which are excellent value and great quality examples of Bordeaux varieties. All of Château Reynier's wines are certified Organic and Vegan from the 2023 vintage onwards.

Château George 7 FRONSAC

Château George 7 is a boutique winery in Fronsac, which is a lesser-known right bank appellation in Bordeaux near Pomerol and St-Émilion. The estate's owner Sally Evans, purchased what was a dilapidated property with 35-year-old Merlot vines in 2015, since then Sally has built a new winery and tasting facility which will ensure the estate's legacy lives on. Committed to sustainability, Château George 7 has shifted to a holistic approach to viticulture and has the highest level of High Environmental Value certification. Changes include mechanical weeding, planting hedgerows for biodiversity to retain balance in the vineyard along with a review of all packaging to ensure sustainability is considered at every stage.

Château Beaumont HAUT-MÉDOC

This expansive estate, which was originally founded in 1824, is ideally located in the centre of the Médoc region, between Saint-Julien and Margaux. Thirty years later, the beautiful Renaissance mansard style castle and vineyards are owned by the GMF (Grands Millésimes de France) group, also owner of Château Beychevelle. With the aim of producing rich and crowd pleasing wine, they have hired consultant Eric Boissenot, a renowned oenologist in Bordeaux who is involved in many estates including Château Latour, Château Margaux, Château Lafite-Rothschild and Château Mouton-Rothschild.

Château Cantemerle HAUT-MÉDOC

Château Cantemerle's vineyard is situated on deep gravel soil between the communes of Macau and Ludon, spanning over 90 hectares. Although it was not initially included in the original 1855 Classification, thanks to the efforts of its owner Caroline de Villeneuve Durfort, Château Cantemerle was added to the list as a Fifth Growth just a few months later. This entry became the first modification to the 1855 Classification.

Château du Moulin Rouge HAUT-MÉDOC

Château du Moulin Rouge, a small but perfectly formed Cru Bourgeois Supérieur estate, was founded in the eighteenth century and has been owned by the same family for thirteen generations. Situated between Margaux and St Julien, the 27 hectare estate is now under the custodianship of brother and sister Lucie Secret and Geoffrey Ribeiro. Just as the generations before them have done, Lucie and Geoffrey are dedicated to respecting the heritage of the estate and winemaking style whilst ensuring that the estate's commitment to sustainable viticulture and modern winemaking allows the Château continue to produce meticulously crafted wines for generations to come.

Château Lanessan HAUT-MÉDOC

Lanessan is an estate that fully deserves its Cru Bourgeois status. It is ideally located on a gravelly plateau in the centre of the Médoc, towards Saint-Julien, overlooking the Gironde. Since 2009, it has been managed by their dynamic winemaker, Paz Espajo. The vineyard spans 45 hectares and the vines have an average age of 30 years.

Domaine Tollot-Beaut CÔTE DE BEAUNE

Domaine Tollot-Beaut was among the group of pioneering Burgundians who started producing and bottling their own wines in the early part of the 20th century. They employ twice as many people per hectare as any of their neighbours, with their efforts focussed on restricting the vigour of the vines and therefore increasing the chances of ripe, concentrated grapes being produced every year. The wines remain respectful to their origins while sharing characteristic spicy, toasty, and cherry fruit flavours.

Provence

Château de Mille

Château de Mille is the oldest vineyard in the Luberon Natural Park, with the oldest vines dating back to 1238. The entire estate covers 116 hectares, with 25 dedicated to vines. Since purchasing the Château in 2018, French-American couple Constance and Lawrence Slaughter have transformed the estate by converting to organic practices, transitioning to biodynamic cultivation, developing an active biodiversity strategy, and modernising winemaking tools. Château des Roques

Domaine Roger Perrin

The Domaine Roger Perrin was formed in 1969 by Roger Perrin and was succeeded by his son Luc in 1986. Sadly, Luc passed away in 2010 at the young age of 45, at which point his sister Veronique took over the reins. The terroir of the Domaine ranges from stone and gravel to sand and limestone soils, totalling 15.63 hectares of vines in Châteauneuf-du-Pape, with plantings extending into Côte du Rhône and d'Orange. The vineyards are divided into 61 separate parcels that are dispersed in different lieux-dits in Châteauneuf-du-Pape.



Bojador Espaço Rural

Espaço Rural is the personal project of Pedro Ribeiro and his wife, Catarine Vieira. They were both winemakers in other Portuguese regions before deciding to move to Vidigueira in the Alentejo. Their goal is to produce wines that are true to the historical traditions of the land. They adopt methods such as low yields, careful pruning and early harvesting in addition to organic farming methods in the vineyard. As a tribute to the winemaking traditions of the region, they ferment some of their wines in impermeable pots called Talha, where the wine and skins must remain in contact until November 11th (St. Martin's Day). The resulting wines are mineral, fresh, elegant and, above all, authentic.

Casa da Passarella is a 150-year-old winery founded by Amand d'Oliveira, who made his fortune in Brazil before coming to the Dão region. After building a beautiful villa in Lagarinhos, he decided to surround it with an impressive 200 hectares of vines. In 2007, Ricardo Cabral took over the estate and his priority was to rebuild the winery as well as focusing on growing indigenous grape varieties. He hired consultant winemaker Paulo Nunes, who produces wines that stand out for their freshness, mineral character, and longevity. Paulo was one of the first to recognise the advantages of the higher altitude vineyards situated in the Serra d'Estrela (700–800m high compared to the other Passarella's vineyards at 400–600m).

Dom Salvador

Quinta da Torre is a family-owned estate in Melgaço where the Salvador family has been producing Alvarinho since 1976. Located in the Vinho Verde sub-region of Monção e Melgaço DOC, where the character of Alvarinho wine was shaped. Dow's

Dow's is considered to be one of the leading Port houses and their wines are amongst the longest lived and most impressive. Founded in 1798 by Bruno da Silva, a Portuguese merchant from Oporto who used to transport its precious cargo of fine Ports under its own armed protection. The firm was also the first British Port producer to invest extensively in premium vineyards, acquiring Quinta da Senhora da Ribeira and Quinta do Bomfim. In 1912, Andrew James Symington became a partner in Dow's, and today six members of the family own the company. The La Brune dream (French for brunette) was born when winemaker Nico Grobler fell in love with Burgundian Chardonnay and Pinot Noir through a close friend and world-renowned vigneron Bruno Lorenzon of Domaine Lorenzon in Mercurey, Burgundy. Since then, with Bruno his tutor, Nico has brought his love of Burgundy's finesse, elegance and purity of fruit to the Elgin Valley in South Africa. The region's close proximity to the Indian Ocean and elevation of up to 500m above sea level, create perfect conditions to produce premium cool climate Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Adegas Pombal a Lanzada

Adegas Pombal a Lanzada is a small family-owned and operated winery drawing from two hectares of vines from some of the finest terroirs of Rías Baixas. The name derives from a long stretch of beach, which the winery overlooks called 'La Playa Lanzada'. The family has been growing grapes and producing wine from their vines for generations, they have only recently made the wine commercially available to the general public. Bodega Miguel Merino

Bodega Miguel Merino is one of the smallest cellars of DOC Rioja. It was founded in 1994 by Miguel Merino Snr, who after many years exporting Spanish wines throughout the world, made his dream of having a small 'bodega' to make the best possible wines, come true. Miguel established his winery in Briones, one of the few areas in Rioja Alta that kept old vineyards. All of the bodega's vineyards are from the surrounding area, spread across no less than 34 parcels of land planted under vine between the end of the 19th century and 2001. The vineyard holdings total almost 13 hectares with just 55,000kgs of grapes harvested on average each year. Traditional and sustainable viticulture practices are followed with no use of herbicides and most of the work carried out by hand. The bodega's reputation has soared in recent years under the stewardship of Miguel's son (also Miguel), reinforced by the recent elevation to Rioja First Growth in Tim Atkin's annual classification.
